BY-LAW NO. S-4

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A CURFEW IN THE TOWN OF NACKAWIC

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Nackawic as follows:

1. <u>General</u>

1.01 No child under the age of sixteen years shall be in a public place at night in the Town of Nackawic after the hour of ten o'clock in the evening unless his or her parent or guardian accompanies the child.

1.02 A child below the age of sixteen years or apparently so found in a public place after the time appointed may be ordered to his or her home by any peace officer, and in case of refusal he or she may be dealt with as a child in need of protection under the *Family Services Act*, with amendments thereto.

2. <u>Penalty Provision</u>

2.01 A parent or guardian who permits his or her child to violate any provision of this by-law commits an offence punishable under Part II of the *Provincial Offences Procedure Act* as a category B offence.

3. <u>Repeal Provision</u>

3.01 By-Law No. 22, A By-Law To Establish A Curfew, passed by Town Council on January 8, 1973 and amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.

3.02 The repeal of By-Law No. 22, A By-Law To Establish A Curfew, and amendments thereto, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
