No matter shall be placed on the agenda for consideration at any regular Council meeting unless the request for consideration of the matter is received by the Chief Administrative Officer, in writing, before 12:00 noon on the Friday preceding the day on which the meeting is to be held.

### SPRING CLEAN UP

Nackawic will be on Friday, May 19, regular garbage pickup on same day. Temperance Vale, Southampton & portions of Queensbury will be the week of May 22-26, same day as your regular garbage day.

NBSPCA are responsible for dog control in Nackawic & Millville. Residents with any and all dog complaints can call 1-877-722-1522 to report issues.



The Municipality asked that you have your dog tagged, so that if your dog is picked up by NBSPCA they can reunite the dog with its owner quickly and easily. 2023 Dog Tags are available at Municipal Office. The cost for dogs that have been vaccinated, spayed or neutered is \$15.00. Fines for not having a dog tag start at \$25.00.



By-law S-3, A By-law relating to the Control & Licensing of Dogs, section 7.03 states, “any person having care, custody or control of a dog shall remove forthwith any excrement deposited by said dog on any property in Nackawic. This does not apply to the dog owner’s property.” Fines range from \$25.00 to \$200.00.

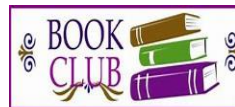

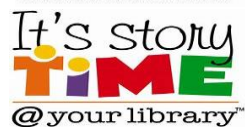
