

## **BY-LAW NO. A-12**

### **A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE REMUNERATION OF COUNCIL FOR THE NACKAWIC-MILLVILLE RURAL COMMUNITY**

**PURPOSE:** A By-law of Nackawic-Millville Rural Community, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the purpose of establishing the remuneration of the council for the Nackawic-Millville Rural Community.

**WHEREAS:** The Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform may make or amend by-laws of a restructured local government as per An Act Respecting Local Governance Reform, section 11(2);

**WHEREAS:** The enactment of this by-law repeals the following by-law(s);

By-law No. A-3. A By-law to Establish Honoraria and Expenses for the Mayor and Council of the Town of Nackawic

By-law No. 22, A By-law of the Municipality of Millville Respecting the Composition of Council and the Remuneration of the Mayor and Councillors

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform as follows:

#### **1. REMUNERATION OF THE COUNCIL**

##### **HONORARIA**

1.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$12,000; the amount being payable in equal instalments.

1.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$6,000; the amounts being payable in equal instalments.

1.03 Each councillor shall be paid an annual salary of \$4,800, the amounts being payable in equal instalments.

1.04 Each member of Council shall be paid an amount of \$23 for each committee meeting attended, the amounts being payable monthly.

##### **2. EXPENSES**

2.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual expense amount of \$1947, the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

2.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual expense amount of \$1550, the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

2.03 Each councillor shall be paid an annual expense amount of \$975, the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

2.04 A member of Council shall be paid an allowance for expenses as follows:

- A) Per Diem \$100.00 maximum per work day lost
- B) Meals/Day A maximum of \$60 per day or any meal in the following proportions:  
breakfast - \$10, lunch - \$20, supper - \$30 (receipts not required)
- C) Kilometer Rate \$.50 per kilometer (same rate as provincial kilometer rate)
