students who will be arriving in September as part of the NB International Student Program. We are currently looking for hosts for two girls from Germany for 1st semester of the coming school year. Becoming a host family to a student from a different country and culture is an enriching and worthwhile experience. Welcoming international students into your home helps develop friendships that will last a lifetime. Visiting students live with a host family, attend regular classes at NHS and participate in family, extracurricular, and community activities for the duration of their visit. A host family does not need to have a child who currently attends NHS. There is also a financial incentive of approximately \$850/month for host families to help compensate for the extra expense of welcoming a guest into their home.
