7.e.1 Monthly Report for June, 2024

A brief overview of the Public Works Committee meeting held June 25, 2024 was given. The Committee discuss the addition of the left hand turn lane along Route 105, the vehicle and pedestrian traffic at the intersection of Route 105 and Landegger and the possibility of adding curbing at that intersection.
