B Internationa Student Program

Nackawic High School, in partnership with Atlantic Education International, participates in the New Brunswick International Student Program each year. This year, NHS is currently hosting 7 students from Germany, Japan, Spain, France, and the Czech Republic. We are currently seeking host families to welcome international students from Brazil into their homes for 2nd semester of the school year, from late January to June. This program provides many benefits to both host families and visiting students as they both get to learn about and appreciate different cultures. Visiting students live with a host family, attend regular classes at Nackawic High School, and participate in extracurricular and community activities for the duration of their visit. A host family does not need to have a child who currently attends school. There is also a \$28.15/day (around \$850/month) non-taxable, financial incentive for host families to help compensate for the extra expense of welcoming a guest for an extended period.
