4.a 2026 Budgets

There is a significant increase in cost to operate a municipality, and costs are continuing to go up. There is no direct impact, to this year's budgets, due to the new sub-division development.

Utility: 7.5% increase in user fees to offset the rising cost to operate and maintain the infrastructure.

General: \$0.02 increase in municipal tax rates across the whole municipality as each department has increased operating cost due to inflation.
